Chapter 9, Paragraph 385, read:

(385) The **Bronx-Whitestone Bridge** is a suspension structure that crosses East River from Old Ferry Point on the Bronx side to a Long Island landing 0.4 mile southwestward of Whitestone Point. The bridge has a clearance of 130 feet with 135 feet at the center; a traveling maintenance platform reduces vertical clearances by 14 feet when in operation.
