## Chapter 6, Paragraph 194, read:

<sup>(194)</sup> Little River (39°09.6'N., 75°24.5'W.) is 26 miles northwest of Cape Henlopen. In 1974, the controlling depth was 2 feet in the entrance channel and 1.5 feet to the fixed highway bridge at the town of Little Creek, 2 miles above the river mouth. An overhead power cable with a clearance of 52 feet crosses the river 0.2 mile below the fixed highway bridge.

<sup>(232)</sup> Ben Davis Point is on the northwest side of the entrance to Nantuxent Cove. Ben Davis Point Shoal, 2.5 miles south-southwest of the point and within 0.4 mile of the main channel through the bay has depths of 7 to 10 feet.

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
