# Corrections

## Chapter 4, Paragraph 267 through Paragraph 268, read:

(267) In 2016, severe shoaling was reported in New Pass from New Pass Lighted Buoy 1 to Buoy 4; local knowledge and extreme caution are advised. A row of pilings, centered in 26°22'42"N., 81°51'53"W., are reported in 1978 to obstruct the channel through New Pass.

(268) Big Carlos Pass, marked by lighted and unlighted buoys, is about 1.5 miles NW of New Pass. A bridge with a 50-foot bascule span crossing Big Carlos Pass from Carlos Point to Black Island has a clearance of 23 feet at the center. (See 117.1 through 117.59 and 117.267, chapter 2, for drawbridge regulations.) Shoaling to bare was reported in 2016 in the Pass to the bridge; local knowledge and extreme caution are advised.
