Corrections

Chapter 12, Paragraph 407, read:

(407) The upper reaches of Taylor Bayou can be reached through Taylor Bayou Outfall Canal at Mile 290.3W which leads N from the waterway to a junction with Taylor Bayou about 2.6 miles above the waterway. Taylor Bayou has depths of about 4 feet for about 29 miles above its junction with the outfall canal. Overhead power cables with a least clearance of 100 feet cross the outfall canal about 1.8 miles above the junction with the Intracoastal Waterway. A swing bridge with a clearance of 11 feet crosses the outfall canal about 2.5 miles above the junction with the Intracoastal Waterway.
