

## **2015 HSRP WORKING GROUP STRUCTURE** **updated May 1, 2015**

The following four working groups were proposed at the Long Beach, California, Public Meeting, April 8-10, 2015. The working groups are under the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) Hydrographic Services Review Panel (HSRP) Federal Advisory Committee. Each working group will report back to the full Panel with any relevant information or recommendations, which the HSRP will take into account in its role as an advisory committee to the NOAA Under Secretary.

### **Working Group #1: Legislative & Policy Initiatives**

This working group focuses on providing expert advice and recommendations on legislative issues such as the reauthorization of the Hydrographic Services Improvement Act. Other areas are to include advice on Administrative and Federal agency policies such as the National Ocean Policy, Ocean Planning, Offshore Energy Development, and other environmental, ocean, and marine transportation related issues.
