

## Color Key for Charts

Type of Chart	Scale	Purpose
<b>HARBOR CHARTS</b> (outlined in red)	1:50,000 and larger	For navigation and anchorage in harbors and small waterways.
<b>GENERAL CHARTS</b> (outlined in purple)	1:150,001 to 1:600,000	For use when a vessel's course is offshore but when its position can be fixed by landmarks, lights, buoys, and characteristic soundings.
<b>SAILING CHARTS</b> (outlined in purple)	1:600,001 and smaller	Plotting charts used for offshore sailing between distant coastal ports and for approaching the coast from the open ocean.

The scale of a chart is the ratio of a given distance on the chart to the actual distance that it represents on the earth. (Example: One unit of measurement on a 1:10,000 scale chart is equal to 10,000 of the same unit on the earth's surface.) **Large-scale charts** show greater detail of a relatively small area. **Small-scale charts** show less detail, but cover a larger area. Certain hydrographic information may be omitted on smaller-scale charts. Mariners should always obtain the largest-scale coverage for near shore navigation.
