"Welcome to the Port of Anchorage"

HSRP Panel members and NOAA staff will meet on the Port of Anchorage Observation Deck for a "Welcome to the Port of Anchorage" conducted Port officials. An overview discussion will include the importance and use of NOAA's navigation data, products & services that support the Alaska shipping industry.

Note: After the "Welcome to the Port of Anchorage" overview is conducted, HSRP Panel members & NOAA staff will split up into two groups of approximately 10-12 persons.

Group I:

Will stay at the Observation Deck (conference room), and receive a talk from port officials. Areas of discussion to include:

- The connection between the marine infrastructure and the intermodal transportation system;
- How consumer products are delivered from the Port of Anchorage to other remote areas;
- Meet with and hear from Totem Ocean Trailer Express representatives on their use of NOAA's Navigation data, products and services; and
- Observe and hear Rich Edwing, Director of CO-OPS talk about NOAA's NWLON Water Level Station at the Port of Anchorage.

Group I:

- Will tour either a Container or RoRo Ship (escorted by Port officials & ship personnel for safety); and
- During the ship tour attendees will receive discussions on how NOAA's navigation data, products, and services are used to maneuver ships in and out of port.

Note: After the ship tour each group will swap tours & discussions. Group I will tour the ship after Group II vice versa.
