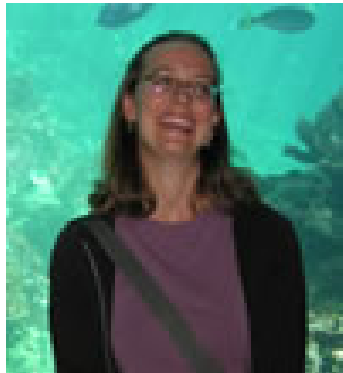
Sara Rothi-Gonzalez will provide congressional remarks on Monday morning.
