Corrections

Chapter 10, Paragraph 66, read:

- (66) A dredged entrance channel leads north from deep water in Lake Huron to a harbor basin and anchorage area formed by two breakwaters. The harbor entrance is marked by lights on the outer ends of the breakwaters. In 2016, the controlling depth was 7 feet in the entrance channel to the basin, thence depths of 7 to 8 feet were available in the basin.
